NEW YORK ([Map](#), [News](#)) - You don't have to go outdoors to lie in a hammock if you stay at Brooklyn's recently opened [Nu Hotel](#) in downtown.

The hotel on Smith Street offers hammocks in its rooms, which can cost up to \$649 a night in a borough that has become an increasingly popular tourist destination.

Nu Hotel designer Guillermo (Gee-YEHR'-moh) Garita (GAH'-dee-tah) says they wanted a sitting space that's not typical of usual hotel rooms.

The rooms also come with beds in case you don't want to sleep in one of the 11-foot cotton hammocks, which are hand-woven in [Nicaragua](#).
