

Brooklyn Hotel Offers Hand-Woven Hammocks

NEW YORK -- You don't have to go outdoors to lie in a hammock if you stay at Brooklyn's recently opened Nu Hotel.

The Smith Street establishment offers 11-foot hammocks in its rooms. It's a cute feature but cute isn't cheap if a stay at Nu can cost up to \$649 a night.

Nu Hotel designer Guillermo Garita says they wanted a sitting space that's not typical of usual hotel rooms.

The rooms also come with beds in case you don't want to sleep in one of the cotton hammocks, which are hand-woven in Nicaragua.

The 93-room Nu Hotel opened last month.
